

## You and the ACC

ACC provides assistance for patients who need dental treatment due to an injury or accident. ACC contributes towards crowns, fillings, extractions, dentures, and implants that are needed as a result of an accident. Usually, you pay part of the treatment cost. We will get pre-approval so you will know the amount of your contribution.

If you have treatment with us for an accident or work-related injury, we will send a claim to ACC. We require you to settle your account with us at this time. When your treatment is approved, ACC will pay us the claim amount. We will then refund this to you directly. The system (called co-payment) requires you to contribute to your ACC dental treatment.

## ACC Dental Implants

If you have lost a tooth through a work, accident or sports related injury, ACC may contribute towards a replacement dental implant tooth. Dental implants are the best long-term option for replacing teeth. An ACC consultation for dental implants is approximately \$115.

## WINZ

If required, we can provide a quote for WINZ for your dental treatment. A consultation fee of approximately \$95 will be payable for this service at the time of consultation appointment.

### Additional benefits:

When you choose GEM Visa, you will be issued with a Visa card which you can swipe through our EFTPOS terminal. If the purchase is over \$250, this immediately gives you 6 months interest-free for any other treatment, such as annual check-ups and hygienist appointments. Many patients use their GEM Visa card as an alternative to using their normal credit cards.
